### Central NSW Joint Organisation Urges Member Councils to Encourage Community Feedback on Transport Plan

The Central NSW Joint Organisation (CNSWJO) is calling on its member councils and their communities to provide feedback on the Central West and Orana Strategic Regional Integrated Transport Plan (the Plan) before the first draft consultation period closes in the first quarter of 2025. While consultation will remain open beyond this, early input is key to shaping the plan. This 20-year vision aims to guide transport planning and infrastructure investment, ensuring the region's unique needs are met and aligned with broader NSW goals.

Transport for NSW is currently seeking input from councils and their communities to shape the Plan. Community insights are vital to developing a transport system that reflects the daily experiences and challenges of those living and working in the Central West and Orana region.

“It’s essential that councils and their communities take this opportunity to shape the future of transport in Central NSW. Freight corridors, road and rail resilience, and the impacts of major infrastructure projects must be properly considered, and that won’t happen without strong regional input,” said Cr Kevin Beatty, Chair of the Central NSW Joint Organisation and Mayor of Cabonne Council.
